Dear parent/guardian,

Please ensure that your child returns in full and correct school uniform, including plain black shoes, and that they have (and wear) the PSN school jacket – which is the only permitted jacket. We do not want to start the year arguing with students about uniform. The rules re uniform and make-up/nails/jewellery are very clear - all students are expected to follow them, and all parents are expected to support them.
